

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-04

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PLACES FOR THE POSTING OF ORDINANCES; PRESCRIBING OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, no newspaper is published in the Town of Pleasant Plains, Arkansas (the "Town"); and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate, pursuant to Act No. 295 of the Acts of Arkansas of 1993, that the Town designate five of the most public places in the Town for posting of notice of the adoption of ordinances of the Town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Pleasant Plains, Arkansas:

Section 1. The following places, which are hereby found to be five of the most public places in the Town, are hereby designated for the posting of notice of the adoption of ordinances of the Town:

- Valero-Corner Store
- Post Office
- Exxon Express
- Dollar General
- Main Street Feed and Seed

Section 2. Notice of the adoption of ordinances of the Town shall be effected by the posting of ordinances at the locations set forth in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. All ordinances and resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4. It has been found that proper notification of the adoption of ordinances of the Town is essential to the governance of the Town. Therefore, an emergency is declared and this Ordinance, being necessary for preservation of the public peace, health and safety, shall be in force upon its passage and approval.
